ENGLISH REVIEW. (GUÍA No.1) THE VERB TO BE

El verbo **TO BE** equivale a decir **SER** o **ESTAR** en español. Es el verbo más irregular que hay, y también el más usado en inglés.

TO BE = SER

I am a new student. (*Yo soy un estudiante nuevo*).

You are very intelligent. (*Tú eres muy inteligente*).

He is from Mocoa. (*Él es de Mocoa*).

She is a very good student. (*Ella es una muy buena estudiante*).

It is a beautiful day. (*Es un día muy bonito*).

We are Colombian. (*Nosotros somos Colombianos*).

You are teenagers. (*Ustedes son adolescentes*)

They are my friends. = (*Ellos son mis amigos*).

TO BE = ESTAR

I am with a new student. (*Yo estoy con un estudiante nuevo*).

You are in my facebbok. (*Tú estás en mi Facebook*).

He is in Bogota. (*Él está Bogota*).

She is very pretty. (*Ella está muy hermosa*).

It is on my desk. (*Está sobre mi escritorio*).

We are in Canada. (*Nosotros estamos en Canada*).

You are at home. (*Ustedes están en casa*)

They are at the university. (*Ellos están en la universidad*).

Obseva los pronombres personales:

I, you, he, she, it (Singulares)

We, you, they (Plurales)

En inglés, no hay una forma para usted. Usamos **YOU** simplemente. Tampoco tenemos palabras diferentes para vosotros o ustedes. También se usa **YOU**.

It se refiere a cosas sin género. Si queremos hablar de una casa, un carro, el tiempo, o algo así, usamos **it**.
